DESIGN BRIEF

The biggest and best little snorkel boat

Adventure was our answer for a repeat client of ours who needed to operate within the National Parks boundaries given their 42' length restriction rules. She is certified to carry 49 passengers and has several sweet unique features: she has double swim/boarding ladders up forward, an underwater window in the central cabin and a pair of 'rumble seats' (splash seats!) up forward for the thrill seekers. Upon entering the sensitive waters of the National Parks she can turn off her diesel and begin using her hybrid electric drive unit which will give her about an hour of time at 6 knots cruise. She has great sun protection, contoured seating, a large private head and numerous railings for passenger safety.

Construction:

 ATC foam, glass and CPD epoxy resin using resin infusion and vacuum bag construction methods and assembled using WEST SYSTEM™ Epoxy resin.

Exterior Finish:

 Alexseal Polyurethane paint over Alexseal epoxy primer--commercial yacht finish TBD

Interior Finish:

 Sherwin Williams waterbase Tileclad in head compartment, grey epoxy coating in engine rooms

Paint Colors & Graphics:

- All gloss white Snow White or TBD
- 2 Coats of bottom paint (3 coats at waterline).
 Color TBD
- Graphics and stripes TBD. PURCHASER to supply logo vinyl graphics if any.
- Hull markings as per USCG minimimum requirements.

Water Systems & Piping

- 1 55 gal. poly water tank w/ Jabsco Ultra Max pressure pump (JM) and deck fill. Hose bib in head.
- Foot pump in head to service sink.
- Water supply hosing is rigid PVC, nylon and reinforced vinyl. PVC and nylon fittings.
- Jabsco salt water wash down pump (JM) w/ hose bib in wingfairing.

Head:

 1 – Jabsco toilet (JM), w/ poly holding tank, Yvalve, seacocks and deck pump out option w/plate.

ENGINE

2 - Steyr MO166K28, 2800 rpm 6 cylinder marine diesels, w/IFG with 2.53:1 ZF 25 A marine gear. Steyr or Morse controls and cables, instrument panel, with RPM, oil pressure, water temp, and engine hour meters, safety alarm, 55 amp alternator, Vernalift wet exhaust, flexible engine mounts, GRW Drivesavers, PYI shaft seal, deadwood enclosed shaft log, 2" SS shaft, 28"x28" 4 blade bronze prop, 2-Odyssey (PC1500 MST) starting batteries. Bronze thru hulls, strainers, USCG approved cooling hoses & Parker fuel lines, copper fule lines? and Racor fuel filters. Two 1/4" Aluminum 100 gallon diesel tanks with SS adapters,



senders and USCG approved vent system. Engine room vent system using Vetus AL intake grill and 4" PVC pipe with manual closures.
