DESIGN BRIEF

The GC70 Power Trimaran has been custom designed for a scheduled ferry service between St. Maarten, Saba and St. Barths. The design features long slender fuel efficient wave piercing hull shapes and a sleek low profile passenger cabin for 30. The primary design parameters are fuel efficiency, ride comfort, vessel cost and to meet SVC regulations.
