- ATC foam, glass and CPD epoxy resin using resin infusion and vacuum bag construction methods and assembled using WEST SYSTEM™ Epoxy resin.
- Thin bows using glass rod and fiberglass

Aluminum fuel tanks with 10 Micron RACOR separators.Smartcraft panels as supplied, fuel senders integrated to displays, Isspro Pyrometers. 2" Sound down foam/ lead soundproofing. Walker Air Sep type system as supplied by Cummins. Engine room access door. ATC foam engine seat/deck hatch.
